

CONSULTATION ON STUTTON'S DRAFT NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN 9th February 2020 to 22nd March 2020

Thank you to everyone who has already been involved in telling us what they think should be in our Neighbourhood Plan.

As a result of this consultation, we have developed a Draft Plan and have prepared a Summary of all the Policies and Community Actions we are proposing. This Summary also identifies the Objectives that we as a village want to achieve. And we have also listed some of the evidence backing up the Policies and Community Actions - a lot of this evidence is what you have told us in the consultation we have done so far.

We do not propose putting any new sites forward over and above those in the pipeline, which already meet the requirement for 64 new houses in Stutton, outlined in Babergh's Local Plan. However, the commitment to support affordable (social) housing on Rural Exception sites remains.

For the plan to be approved by a Planning Inspector, the policies have to be consistent with national and local planning policy, namely the National Planning Policy Framework and Babergh District Council's Local Plan. Once approved, these policies will carry equal weight in planning decisions, e.g. on housing development.

Community Actions are what we as a village can do. Many of the things you told us about can be addressed by us taking action as a community.

We welcome and would like to hear what you think about this Summary of our Draft Plan.
